

## 301 Wardrop Street - Court House



The Morden Court House was opened in 1905. The construction of a court building in Morden confirmed the community's emerging significance in the province.

Local granite boulders were used in the construction. The stones were free for the taking and are said to have been used as a cost cutting measure. The structure is neoclassical in design with 18<sup>th</sup> century Georgian origins. Architectural details include projecting stones or quoins, a well-proportioned cornice and a semicircular pediment over the three central bays.
