

303 North Railway St. - Travellers Inn



The first hotel established on this site in 1884 – the Commercial House, owned by Solomon Johns - was destroyed by fire in 1895.

This building - then called the Hotel Manitoba – was opened on October 10, 1895. It was described as having 50 by 90 foot stone basement, 32 bedrooms, two sample rooms, three stories of solid brick, hot air heat, electric lights and bells, hot and cold water, a dining hall capable of accommodating 150 people, public and private parlours and hotel offices.
